

BY-LAWS

Tuckahoe Lodge No. 347 A.F. & A.M.
Richmond, Virginia

ARTICLE I

The stated communications of this Lodge shall be held at the Masonic Temple 5500 Bethlehem Road, Richmond Virginia on the First Thursday of Each Month at 7:15 P.M. o'clock.

ARTICLE II

Every member of this Lodge except the Treasurer, Secretary, Tiler, and one Chaplain shall be charged by the Secretary with the sum of Fifty-Five Dollars plus Grand Lodge dues and assessments as Annual dues.

ARTICLE III

The total fees for the degrees in this Lodge, including that amount which must accompany the petition, shall be One Hundred Thirty Dollars, payable as follows:
Forty Dollars for the Degree of Entered Apprentice; and
Forty Dollars for the Degree of Fellowcraft; and
Forty Dollars for the Degree of Master Mason; and
Ten Dollars shall accompany the petition.

ARTICLE IV

The Treasurer shall receive an annual compensation of Five Hundred Eighty Dollars, payable in Quarterly installments.

ARTICLE V

The Secretary shall receive an annual compensation of Five Hundred Eighty Dollars, payable in Quarterly installments.

ARTICLE VI

The Tiler, or Acting Tiler, shall receive a compensation of Twenty Dollars for each communication he attends in that capacity.

ARTICLE VII

The Three Trustees, who shall be recommended by the Lodge and appointed by the Court having jurisdiction, shall at each annual stated communication in December make a report of the investment of all funds and condition of property entrusted to their care.

ARTICLE VIII

Any amendment proposed to these by-laws must be submitted in writing at a stated communication, lie over the required four weeks, the membership be notified, and shall require a Two-Thirds affirmative vote of the members present for its adoption.

CERTIFICATION
